- Outline:** This course covers NFPA-99C, 2005 edition and meets the requirements of ASSE-6010. The National Inspection and Testing Corporation (NITC) will administer and certify the testing process.
- Testing:** The test will be on Friday morning and finish early afternoon. There will be 100 written questions in a closed book format. The brazing of two 1-1/2" copper joints, one horizontal, one vertical (both upflow) will be conducted afterward the written exam.
- Materials:** **Bring this with you:**
NFPA-99C, 2005 edition (supplied by AMGI upon payment)
Two passport size (1" x 1-1/4") photos
Safety Glasses
Eight to Ten 1-1/2" couplings
Eight to Ten Feet of 1-1/2" tubing (does not have to be cleaned)
A half to one pound of 5-15% BCuP series silvfloss rods
- Torches:** We will be using an acetylene turbo-torch. If you are driving down and wish to use your own rig, please call and let us know.
